Attendance, Punctuality and term time holidays

As you know, good attendance is vital for your child to make the most of their time in education. We monitor attendance closely and try to work closely with families to support any child whose attendance is of a concern.

Traditionally, the Summer term sees a rise in Holidays being taken during term time. Please note that for any absence parents/ carers need to complete an absence request form – please contact the office for one. No term time holidays will be authorised. Should the school have any concerns about your child/ren's attendance we will make contact with you early to discuss a support plan, in order to improve their punctuality/attendance.

A Fixed Penalty Notice Warning letter may be issued at 5 days unauthorised absence, and the Fixed Penalty Notice may be issued at 10 days unauthorised absence.

When filling out Absence Request Forms, it is important for parents/carers to add as much information as possible. An example would be for family weddings- please add where the wedding is to take place and the day of the wedding as this informs decisions regarding any potential authorised/unauthorised days. It is also worth noting that the school day starts here at Frongoch at 8.45am and good punctuality is essential in allowing your child to come into school settled and ready for the school day ahead. Any child arriving after 9.15am [ie 30 minutes late] is marked down as an Unauthorised Absence.

Outdoor Learning

Today, all children have had the opportunity to partake in some outdoor learning sessions alongside Mrs N Smith from Learning through Landscapes. The children enjoyed being creative with various equipment to complete challenges and having a go at Hapa Zome, a Japanese printing technique. Many thanks to Mrs Smith for the time she has spent with us, demonstrating activities and helping us to build our outdoor provision for the children at Ysgol Frongoch.
