Parking

As you know, our new School Crossing Patrol officer has now started her job. As part of this job she has been subject to supervision from Denbighshire County Council's Road Safety Officers. During visits to the site the Road Safety Officers highlighted ongoing concerns about the following issues regarding parents/ carers from both Twm o'r Nant and Frongoch in relation to their parking:

- Parents/ carers using the staff car park for picking up/ dropping off their children, even when there is clear signage reminding parents/carers to use the parent car park and not putting our children in danger by using the staff car park
- Parents/ carers parking in front of the main gates
- Parents/ carers using the disabled parking bay in the parent/carer car park without the necessary blue badge
- Parents/ carers parking on Castle View Estate in a way that makes it dangerous for our children to navigate their way into school

It was shared with the Road Safety Officers that regular reminders are given on Newsletters which are sent to all parents/ carers. However, it is clear that further action is required by the necessary authorities who have the power to enforce Road safety. It was agreed that Road Traffic Officers, and the Police, will be advised of the above concerns and we hope to have their presence at the key times of the day to begin to enforce the relevant laws which are there to help protect our children.

Term time holidays

Please may I remind all parents/ carers that we do not authorise term time holidays. Anybody who will be taking their child/ren out of school again this academic year for a term time holiday, who have already had



one term time holiday un-authorized since September 2025, will to receive a Fixed Penalty Notice warning letter as a result.
